2019 MCPA Proposed Bylaw Amendments

The MCPA Board of Directors is proposing an amendment to the current MCPA bylaws that will move Phelps County from District 3 to District 5 and Camden County from District 5 to District 3. Members currently in Phelps and Camden County will have the option to be grandfathered into their current county if they so wish.

Please read the following information if you are considering voting for these offices, whether in person or by absentee ballot. MCPA Bylaws will be followed to protect the integrity of the election process.

Election Guidelines:

Nominees will be put on the ballot alphabetically.

- Elections will be held on **Thursday, August 1, 2019**, at the MCPA Summer Convention General Membership Meeting at The Lodge of Four Seasons Golf Resort, Marina & Spa in Lake Ozark, Missouri.
- There will be no floor nominations at Summer Convention, other than for Member at Large.

Absentee Ballots:

- Any member who will be unable to attend the summer convention may request an Official Absentee Ballot from the State Office at any time prior to **Monday, July 1, 2019**.
- Official ballots must be returned to the State Office no later than **Wednesday, July 17, 2019**.
- Ballots will not be opened until the summer convention general meeting.

Voting Eligibility:

- MCPA members must have their dues paid in full or have paid the preceding four (4) quarters of their dues to be eligible to vote at summer convention.
- Associate, student, and honorary members shall not be entitled to vote or hold office.
